(Montgomery, AL) Grammy Award-winning country music star **Clint Black** will headline *An Evening with Clint Black*, an outdoor concert on the grounds of the Alabama Shakespeare Festival on Saturday, April 8 at 8 p.m. This spectacular event will also include two additional bands, which will be named at a later date. *An Evening with Clint Black* will take place rain or shine. Gates open at 4 p.m.

Clint Black is celebrating 25 years since the debut of his legendary and landmark album *Killin' Time*. Black has sold over 20 million records, charted 22 number one country singles and is a Grammy Award-winner. Among Black's best-known hits are *Killin' Time*, *Like the Rain*, *When I Said I Do* and *Nothin' But the Taillights*.

Music industry accolades include Country Music Association Male Vocalist of the Year, Country Music Horizon Award, AMA Favorite New Male Country Artist, ACM Best New Male Vocalist, ACM Album of the Year, and ACM Single of the Year.
