The fairy tale that inspired Disney's *Frozen* and the White Witch character in *The Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe* comes to magical life on ASF's Octagon Stage.

The actors in the production are members the Alabama Shakespeare Festival's resident touring company, who auditioned in New York to receive coveted year-long apprenticeship positions with The Alabama Shakespeare Festival, and have come from all over the country to spend a year living in Montgomery. Aside from the production of **SNOW QUEEN**, they were recently scene in ASF's **A Christmas Carol** and a touring production of Shakespeare's **Much Ado About Nothing** that travels to schools and theatres across the state of Alabama.

Katie Fanning appears as the Snow Queen with **Woodrow Procter** as her faithful hobgoblin servant, Hemming. **Lara Treacy** plays the intrepid Gerda with **Colin Wulff** as Gerda's friend Kai whom she must rescue. Gerda's grandfather is played by **Ithamar Francois**, **Josh Cahn** appears as Halvard the reindeer, **Brian Ott** as Ragnvald and **Collin M. Purcell** as Trygve the Raven. Several of the actors play additional ensemble roles.

SNOW QUEEN is directed by Nancy Rominger, the Associate Artistic Director of the Alabama Shakespeare Festival. In recent seasons Rominger directed highly successful productions of Alice in Wonderland, Cinderella and Charlotte's Web, and most recently directed the 2017 ASF production of A Christmas Carol.
