



Alabama Shakespeare Festival seeks Teachers for Camp Shakespeare 2019

Alabama Shakespeare Festival (ASF) is currently seeking teachers for Camp Shakespeare and Broadway South. Teachers will be responsible for the development of curriculum, teaching campers, and directing a final performance or showcase as well as maintaining a fun, artistic, engaging, and productive learning environment for campers. Professionals with a background in acting, dance, voice, stage combat, Shakespeare, and other theatrical experience are encouraged to apply.

Camp dates are June 3 to July 26. You do not need to be available for the entire summer; contracts are for specific camp weeks. The span of day for teachers is 8:15 a.m. - 4:15 p.m., Monday through Friday. We do not have camp July 1-5.

Job Responsibilities:

- Develop curriculum and lesson plans for camp
- Teach campers age-appropriate skills that build towards a final performance
- Direct the camp's final performance
- Supervise counselors in the classroom
- Communicate consistently with the Education department, ASF staff, and counselors
- Attend a pre-camp training in May

Qualifications:

- Must be at least 21 years of age
- Candidates with a completed BA/BFA in theatre, musical theatre or a related field are preferred
- Experience performing, directing, and/or teaching Shakespeare, musical theatre, acting, dance, vocal performance, or other theatre arts
- Exhibit dependability, punctuality, patience, teamwork, self-control, and enthusiasm
- Possess good leadership skills and responsibility
- Demonstrate appropriate behavior at all times
- Have an ability and a desire to work with children
- Communicate positively with campers and staff
- All final-round candidates will be required to undergo a standard background check before being offered a contract. Employment offers are contingent on satisfactory results.
