Action on Stage

Surprising Moments

House Manager gives curtain speech	Christopher Robin will enter to show audiences his guitar. We will then meet the actors for the first time, holding cardboard cutouts of their respective characters. The lights will dim before the show begins.
Pooh does his morning exercises	Pooh will begin singing accompanied by Christopher Robin on guitar.
Pooh and Piglet talk about remembering	Rabbit enters in a high energy jump trailing lots of stuffed bunnies. These are his "friends and relations."
Pooh, Piglet, and Rabbit discuss Rabbit's friends and relations	All three actors sing a song accompanied by Christopher Robin on guitar.
Rabbit has something very important to tell Pooh and Piglet	Rabbit is wary of Kanga, and hatches a plot to get her and Roo to leave 100 Acre Woods.
Rabbit, Pooh, and Piglet discuss their plan to make Kanga and Roo leave the woods	All three actors say "Aha!" repeatedly.
Pooh and Piglet decide to use honey for their Heffalump trap	Pooh sings about honey, accompanied by Christopher Robin on guitar. Rabbit enters in a hurry.
Rabbit brings Kanga and Roo to meet Pooh	Roo enters at an energetic jump. Both Kanga and Roo speak Spanish.
Pooh and Rabbit discuss their plan again. Rabbit exits	Eeyore enters. He is very grumpy.
Pooh and Eeyore discuss Owl's use of "Cottleston Pie" to solve riddles	Pooh sings a song accompanied by Christopher Robin on guitar.
Pooh finishes singing "Cottleston Pie"	Pooh discovers Eeyore's tail is missing. Pooh and Eeyore both speak in fast, excited voices. Eeyore turns his rear towards the audience to show his missing tail. People may laugh.

Pooh decides to go see Owl about Eeyore's missing tail	Eeyore is very sad about his tail.
Rabbit enters with Piglet's Roo disguise	Piglet puts on the disguise and jumps around pretending to be Roo.
Eeyore and Piglet discuss Eeyore's birthday	Eeyore sings a song accompanied by Christopher Robin on guitar.
Pooh approaches Owl's home	Owl speaks in a British accent.
Pooh leaves Owl's house with Eeyore's tail	Piglet enters dressed as Roo. It frightens Pooh.
Pooh returns Eeyore's tail	Eeyore is so happy to get his tail back, he dances around with Christopher Robin. Pooh then sings a song accompanied by Christopher Robin on guitar.
Piglet enters looking for Eeyore. She is holding a large red balloon.	Piglet trips and pops the balloon. It is loud and surprising. Piglet becomes very sad.
Piglet gives Eeyore the popped balloon	Eeyore becomes sad over his ruined present.
Pooh eats honey out of the jar while wondering if the Heffalump will really like it	Pooh gets his head stuck in the honey jar. He stumbles around and makes a lot of noise.
Piglet and Kanga enter at the same time	Piglet and Kanga bump into each other. Kanga forces Piglet to take a bath, even though she doesn't want to. She is very upset.
Kanga gives Piglet a bath	Kanga realizes Piglet is not Roo. She is very surprised and distressed.
Piglet laments how clean she is	Piglet sings a song accompanied by Christopher Robin on guitar.
Roo comes out, unable to sleep	Kanga sings a lullaby, accompanied by Christopher Robin on guitar.
Piglet looks for Pooh to go to the Heffalump pit	Pooh enters with the honey jar still stuck, stomping and roaring. Piglet is very afraid he is the Heffalump and screams.
Christopher Robin comes in to help Piglet with the Heffalump	Christopher Robin pulls the honey jar off Pooh's head and Pooh stumbles.

Pooh is relieved to finally be freed from the honey jar	Piglet is very sad about the terrible day she has had.
Rabbit invites Piglet to Kanga's for dinner	Eeyore enters with the popped balloon. He is still very sad. Christopher Robin gives him the honey jar, and he becomes happy.
Eeyore is excited by his "Useful Pot" birthday present	Everyone sings a song, accompanied by Christopher Robin on guitar.
End of show	The house lights will become brighter again. All of the actors will bow. The audience may applaud.

Miscellaneous:

- The stage lights will change in brightness throughout the show.
- The actors are very silly and active. You may see them give each other piggy back rides, sit on each other's back, wheelbarrow, or climb between someone's legs.
- The actors rotate the tree set pieces during the show.
- Christopher Robin may ask the audience if they are having fun, or if they liked the song. Response is optional.
- The audience may applaud after songs and at the end of the show. Applause is optional.
