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ARTIST BIOGRAPHIES



David Lee Nelson (1978-2020) (playwright and performer) was an award-winning actor, playwright, and solo performer. His TV and film credits included: *Turn* (AMC) *The Inspectors* (CBS), *Daytime Divas* (VH1), *Nashville* (CMT). He created four solo plays with collaborator Adam Knight: *Silence of Lucky* (78th Street Theatre Lab, Piccolo Spoleto Festival); *Status Update* (Out

of the Loop Festival, Edinburgh Festival Fringe, 59E59 in NYC, Piccolo Spoleto Festival; "Best Touring Production" of the 2010/2011 theatre season by the Dallas/Ft. Worth Critics); *The Elephant in My Closet* (Piccolo Spoleto, Out of the Loop - "Best of Festival" Winner, Cincinnati Fringe Festival, Capital Fringe Festival, NC Stage Company); and *Stages* (PURE Theatre, Riverside Theatre). Full length plays include *Folly Beach* (PURE Theatre, SPACE at Ryder Farm), *A Sudden Spontaneous Event* (PURE Theatre, Alabama Shakespeare Festival's Southern Writers' Festival). As an actor, credits included: *Stupid F**cking Bitch* by Lucy Alibar (EST/Youngblood); *Binge* by Thomas Ward (Slant Theatre Project); *Keeping Watch* (Piccolo Spoleto); *Every Brilliant Thing* (Alabama Shakespeare Festival and Warehouse Theatre); *Much Ado About Nothing* (Warehouse Theatre); and *Hamlet* (College of Charleston).

Adam Knight (Director; Producing Artistic Director) joined Riverside Theatre in Fall 2018, after seventeen years in New York City. He was founder and co-Artistic Director of Slant Theatre Project, an Off Off-Broadway company that produced more than two dozen world premieres, working with a large roster of emerging artists. Adam also served as Executive Director of Red Lab, an

international collective dedicated to cultural diplomacy through art and performance. He made his Riverside debut with Arthur Miller's *The Price*. Past directing credits include work at Alabama Shakespeare Festival, Ensemble Studio Theatre, Folger Shakespeare Theatre, Williamstown Theatre Festival, and PURE Theatre. Adam created four solo shows with David Lee Nelson, touring across the country and to Edinburgh, and had the honor of directing him in *Hamlet* in Charleston in 2013.

Chris Rich (Scenic Designer; Technical Director) is a technical director, lighting, scenic, and sound designer with over twenty-five years' professional and academic experience. Prior to his work here in lowa, he worked predominantly in the Southeast. He has served on the boards of the Southeastern Theatre Conference and Alabama Conference of Theatre. He has been honored to be the recipient of the Marian Galloway Award for Contributions to Theatre in Alabama and the national winner of the

Kennedy Center American College Theatre Festival Special Achievement Recognition for Lighting and Sound Design for his work on Troy University's Two Rooms. Chris also serves as host of the Sunday Sound Salon, a monthly lowa City based community development event that incorporates storytelling around the music of our lives.

She has held residencies at JENA Co (NYC), Classical Theatre of Harlem (NYC), the late Bottom Line Cabaret (NYC), PURE Theatre (Charleston, SC), Etcetera Theatre (London), and has worked extensively for NYC Fashion Week, Piccolo Spoleto Festival, British MTV, VHI, CMT, and Kevin Bacon.

Miles Boinest (Original Sound Design) is a theatre artist native to Charleston, SC and a graduate of the Savannah College of Art and Design. A champion of new works and regional exposure to the highest caliber of contemporary theatre, Miles is proud to have found an artistic home at PURE Theatre for the past six years.
