### **CHARACTER BREAKDOWN FOR *A MIDSUMMER NIGHT'S DREAM***

- Little boy (6-10 years old) who is perhaps a “future Puck” for the fairy kingdom, good listener, joyful. Will speak text and likely sing.

### **CHARACTER BREAKDOWN FOR *A CHRISTMAS CAROL***

TINY TIM (Male Identifying, 6-8, Any Ethnicity) Bob Cratchit's young son, crippled from birth. Represents the Christmas spirit with hope and goodness.

PETER CRATCHIT (Male Identifying, 13-16, Any Ethnicity) Bob's oldest son, who inherits his father's stiff-collared shirt for Christmas.

MARTHA CRATCHIT: Female, late teens. Bob Cratchit's oldest child who has moved out but who makes it home for Christmas, knowing how important it is to the family.

BELINDA CRATCHIT: Female, pre-mid teen. Bob Cratchit's younger daughter.

SUSAN CRATCHIT: Female, pre-mid teen. Bob Cratchit's younger daughter.

PETER CRATCHIT: Male, early teens. Bob Cratchit's oldest son, on the brink of adulthood but not quite there yet.

FANNY: Female, pre-mid teen. Scrooge's Sister. Her warmth is such that she can make even Boy Scrooge's saddest day better.

BOY EBENEZER: Male, pre-teen. Scrooge as a child is sullen and lonely, mostly content to bury himself in books rather than engage the world around him.

DICK WILKINS: Male, late teen or early twenties. Young Ebenezer's best friend, an outgoing and confident young man.

CECELIA FEZZIWIG: Female, early teens. Mr. Fezziwig's daughter.
